Total campus enrollment as of the close of on-campus registration is 36,281. This total is 540 more students than Spring Semester 2004, with -177 fewer graduate students, 3 more professional students, and 714 more undergraduate students.

Last year, 1,003 students enrolled after on-campus registration. If the number of late registrants parallels that of last year, the final enrollment as of the tenth day of classes will be approximately 37,284.

A final enrollment report for Spring Semester 2005 will be issued after the tenth day of classes.
