As of the close of the tenth day of class, Spring 2005 total enrollment is 38,396. This is 1,652 more students than the corresponding date last year.

Graduate enrollment increased by 898 students this year while Professional students increased by 6. Our Undergraduate enrollment increased by 748.

New Freshman enrollment increased by 15 students. New Transfer enrollment decreased by -28 students.
